The Regular Meeting of the Lingle Town Council convened at 5:00 PM May 19, 2021 with Mayor Siglin leading the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were present, constituting a quorum:

Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Siglin called for approval of the agenda. CM Welte moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Siglin called for approval of the minutes of the May 5, 2021 regular council meeting. CM Welte moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Edwardson voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT: LaDonna Fegler representative of the South Torrington Water and Sewer District requested use of Whipple Park for a fundraiser. The funds will be used to purchase a sprinkler system in Adam Walters Park. The event is planned for August 10, 2021 and will feature artist Brenn Hill performing a live concert. Following discussion, the Council approved the request and CM Cook will be the liaison for the Lingle Town Council.

ADMINISTRATIVE: C Reyes reported: The Annual Water Quality Report, 2020 Consumer Confidence Report, was submitted to the EPA; Information requested by the State of Wyoming for America Rescue Plan Act Funds was submitted.

ORDINANCES: FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE #352 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE TOWN OF LINGLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2021 TO JUNE 30, 2022.

Following discussion of Ordinance #352 CM Welte moved to approve the first reading of the ordinance. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS: CM Siglin proposed amending Ordinance #301 to allow the parking of RV's, boats and trailers on town streets from May 1st to October 31st. CM Siglin proposed amending the Variance portion of Ordinance #195 with the publication statute to read: To be heard at the first Council Meeting ten

days after publication. He asked Council Members to consider the changes and that Council will revisit them in the future.

COUNCIL ITEMS: Mayor Siglin informed the Council and attendees of an effort to reinstate recycling in Goshen County; Council was asked to check their personal schedules so that town employee work reviews could be conducted the week of May 24th, 2021.

With no further action to be taken Mayor Siglin adjourned the meeting at 5:40 PM.
