ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C/T Reyes reported: Request for bids for construction of a storage building for the landfill closure will be published October 22 and 29, 2025 and due November 5, 2025 at 4 PM at Town Hall. The sealed bids will be opened and tabulated at the November 5, 2025 town council meeting; The signed MoU for the Chugwater Wind Energy Project has been successfully submitted.
