Mayor Foster welcomed all in attendance and thanked them for being present. Mayor Foster called for approval of the agenda. CM Wilhelm moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Lambert voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Foster called for approval of the minutes of the November 5, 2025 regular council meeting. CM Wilhelm moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Jerome voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

MAINTENANCE ITEMS: TS Dailey reported: Pine Bluffs Sinclair is scheduled to set fuel tanks this week. A specific date has not yet been confirmed; TDS issued a complaint regarding improper items being deposited in dumpsters. Residents are asked to be mindful of appropriate disposal; Routine maintenance continues.

LVFD ITEMS: CM Lambert reported: The Giving Tree promotion will proceed again this year. A tree will be placed at Town Hall. To date, \$3,000.00 have been collected toward a \$6,000.00 goal.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C/T Reyes reported: He will attend the Chugwater Wind Project meeting November 21, 2025; The copier maintenance contract has been renewed at the cost of \$58 per month, unchanged from last year; All town facilities will be closed November 27 - 28, 2025 in observance of the Thanksgiving holiday.

NEW BUSINESS: Mayor Foster called for consideration of the bid submitted by Goshen County Construction. CM Wilhelm moved to approve the bid in the amount of \$176,500.00 for the construction of a metal storage building at the Lingle Transfer Station. CM Lambert voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.
