Mayor Foster welcomed all in attendance and thanked them for being present. Mayor Foster called for approval of the agenda. CM Wilhelm moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Jerome voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Foster called for approval of the minutes of the February 4, 2026 regular council meeting. CM Wilhelm moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Lambert voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

POLICE ITEMS: PC Andrews reported: that the majority of her time during the reporting period was dedicated to traffic enforcement activities. She, along with DCT Garner and TS Dailey, met with the Chief of the Torrington Police Department to discuss a potential increase in dispatch services fees.

MAINTENANCE ITEMS: TS Dailey reported: A landfill fire, which occurred the previous evening due to high winds, has been successfully extinguished. Additionally, dead trees have been removed from the cemetery. A grant request has been submitted to the Recreation Board, and TS Dailey will attend the upcoming meeting on March 4, 2026, to address any questions. Furthermore, stop signs have been installed, and TS Dailey requested the Council's decision regarding the installation of a stop sign on Freimuth Street. After discussion, the Council reached a consensus to approve the installation of the stop sign.

LVFD ITEMS: CM Lambert reported: The coyote hunt went well with twenty-three teams competing.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C/T Reyes reported: On his attendance at the WAM Winter Meeting, which proved to be highly informative. He also provided an update on pending legislation in the Wyoming Senate and House that could potentially impact the Town of Lingle.

With no further business to come before the Council, Mayor Foster adjourned the meeting at 6:17 p.m.
