Mayor Foster welcomed all in attendance and thanked them for being present. Mayor Foster called for approval of the agenda. CM Wilhelm moved to approve the agenda with the additions. CM Jerome voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Foster called for approval of the minutes of the January 22, 2025 regular council meeting. CM Wilhelm moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Lambert voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

BILLS FOR JANUARY 2025: CM Lambert moved to approve payment of the town bills in the amount of \$124,060.74. CM Wilhelm voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

POLICE ITEMS: PC Andrews reported: She has been investigating: aggravated assault, DFS cases, attended District and Circuit court cases and been conducting traffic.

LEGAL ITEMS: TA Barnes reported: She has been working with DCT Garner on No Show traffic tickets. Demand letters have been issued to said clients; TA Barnes has been working with TS Dailey and WYRULEC on a boundary agreement in reference to electrical service provided by the Town of Lingle and WYRULEC on the west side of town. When the agreement is drawn it will be submitted to the council for approval.

MAINTENANCE ITEMS: TS Dailey reported: The department is still accepting bids for construction of a storage building at the landfill; A power point presentation was presented on the Lingle/WYRULEC proposed service agreement for clarification of the service area on the west side of town; The community garden area is being prepared for use as is the geodome.

LVFD ITEMS: CM Lambert reported: Eight ambulance calls and two fire calls last month.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C/T Reyes reported: The Red Cross Licensed Provider agreement has been approved by the Red Cross; The council agreed to advertise for Pool Manager and Assistant Pool Manager positions in the local newspaper.
