LVFD ITEMS: CM Lambert reported: During the past month, the department responded to five ambulance calls and six fire calls. The annual Easter Egg Hunt is scheduled for April 4, 2026, at 1:00 PM in Whipple Park.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C/T Reyes reported: The closeout process for ARPA funds has been initiated. The 67th Army Band is scheduled to perform a concert in Whipple Park on June 28, 2026, at 1:00 PM.

NEW BUSINESS: Following discussion, the council tabled action on providing monetary support for the Hazardous Waste Cleanup Day, sponsored by the Lingle-Fort Laramie Conservation District. CM Wilhelm moved to approve the Recreation Board Grant. CM Duncan voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.
