The Regular Meeting of the Lingle Town Council convened at 6:00 PM April 22, 2026 with Mayor Foster leading the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were present, constituting a quorum:

Mayor Foster welcomed all in attendance and thanked them for being present. Mayor Foster called for approval of the agenda with the addition of Tree Board member, Sara Ingram, to Public Comment. CM Lambert moved to approve the agenda with the addition. CM Duncan voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Foster called for approval of the minutes of the April 8, 2026 regular council meeting. CM Wilhelm noted corrections to the council minutes of April 8, 2026; Under Council Items CM Duncan's name was omitted. CM Duncan also noted the name of the project to take place May 6, 2026 is Reality Town. C/T Reyes will make the necessary corrections. CM Lambert moved to approve the minutes with the noted corrections. CM Duncan voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Sara Ingram, Tree Board member, presented a bid from Roy's Tree Service for the treatment and/or removal of trees at the Lingle Cemetery. The bid totaled \$16,800.00. No action was taken.

POLICE ITEMS: PC Moen reported: the police vehicle has undergone various repairs and that her duties have been focused on routine operations.

MAINTENANCE ITEMS: TS Dailey reported: ATS Jackson is attending the Wyoming Association of Rural Water Systems water conference. Construction of the pole barn at the transfer station is in progress. The cemetery sprinklers have been installed and are operational, and the cemetery sign will be repainted. Preparations for the pool opening have also begun.

LVFD ITEMS: FC Bangerter reported: A state fire ban is currently in effect. Tornado siren tests will commence, with the first test scheduled for April 29, 2026, at 11:00 AM.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C/T Reyes reported: liquor license renewal applications have been returned by applicants. The municipal election location notice for the Lingle municipal election has been published and posted, and absentee and mail-in ballots are now available.

NEW BUSINESS: Resident Cheryl Trimble withdrew her request to use the Lingle Community Center.

APPOINTMENTS: By consensus, the Lingle Town Council appointed applicant Brian Ingram to serve the remaining two-year term vacated by Jeff Jerome. Mr. Ingram took the oath of office and assumed his seat on the Council.

COUNCIL ITEMS: Council Member Duncan recommended that a formal policy or ordinance be adopted regarding the installation of stop signs. Mayor Foster suggested that this matter be addressed

following the upcoming municipal election. Council Member Duncan also presented ideas for the 250th anniversary celebration of the United States, including the installation of a time capsule near the band shell in the park, the creation of a tile mural composed of 250 hand-painted tiles, and a community potluck to dedicate the mural.

With no further business to come before the Council, Mayor Foster adjourned the meeting at 6:22 p.m.
