The Regular Meeting of the Lingle Town Council convened at 6:00 PM May 20, 2026 with Mayor Foster leading the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were present, constituting a quorum:

Mayor Foster welcomed all in attendance and thanked them for being present. Mayor Foster called for approval of the agenda. CM Wilhelm moved to approve the agenda with the addition of George Siglin to Public Comment. CM Duncan voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Foster called for approval of the minutes of the May 6, 2026 regular council meeting. CM Duncan moved to approve the minutes as submitted. CM Wilhelm voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** George Siglin addressed the council and announced that he has ordered 144 U.S. flags, which he will donate for distribution to Lingle residents in honor of the Semiquincentennial. Once received, residents will be able to pick up a flag for their yard at the town office.

**POLICE ITEMS:** PC Moen reported: Her time has been devoted to traffic.

**MAINTENANCE ITEMS:** Preparation of the cemetery for Memorial Day is currently underway. Repairs to the pool are nearing completion. The Consumer Confidence Report has been completed, confirming that the town's water supply meets all quality standards. During an inspection, Midco Diving identified a small hole in the water tank; it poses no threat to drinking water quality, and a repair proposal has been submitted. Maintenance on the main broom of the street sweeper is scheduled. TS Dailey has communicated with four property owners regarding weed concerns, and they have agreed to address the issues. Cleanup Week is scheduled for the first week of June. TS Dailey also attended an EPA rules and regulations meeting; any resulting changes are not yet known.

**ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS:** C/T Reyes reported: Most of his time has been dedicated to completing the ordinances submitted to the council.

**NEW BUSINESS:** CM Wilhelm moved to appoint George Siglin the voting delegate for the Town of Lingle at the WAM Summer Workshop. CM Duncan voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

**ORDINANCES:** **FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE #376 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE TOWN OF LINGLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2026 TO JUNE 30, 2027.** Following discussion, CM Duncan moved to approve the first reading of Ordinance #376. CM Wilhelm voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

**FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE #377 AN ORDINANCE RENEWING A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO *TDS COLLECTION SERVICE INC., A WYOMING CORPORATION, TO***

**OPERATE A TRASH AND GARBAGE COLLECTION SYSTEM IN THE TOWN OF LINGLE, WYOMING: DEFINING TERMS: SETTING FORTH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE GRANT; PROVIDING FOR COMPANY RULES, RATES, FRANCHISE FEES; TERMINATION AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.** Following discussion, CM Wilhelm moved to approve the first reading of Ordinance #377. CM Duncan voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

**FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE #378 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE NINE, CHAPTER FIVE AND SECTION FOUR OF THE LINGLE TOWN CODE OF THE TOWN OF LINGLE, WYOMING SETTING RATES FOR GARBAGE SERVICE AND REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.** Following discussion, CM Duncan moved to approve the first reading of Ordinance #378. CM Wilhelm voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

**COUNCIL ITEMS:** CM Duncan expressed interest in attending the WAM Summer Workshop. CT Reyes will look in to the registration process.
