The Regular Meeting of the Lingle Town Council convened at 6:00 PM September 9, 2026 with Mayor Siglin leading the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were present, constituting a quorum:

Mayor Siglin welcomed all in attendance and thanked them for being present. Mayor Siglin called for approval of the agenda as presented. CM Wilhelm moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Duncan voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Siglin called for approval of the minutes of the August 5, 2026 regular council meeting. CM Duncan moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Wilhelm voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

BILLS: CM Duncan moved to approve payment of the town's bills for the month of August 2026 totaling \$132,460.19. CM Wilhelm voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Kyle Borger was unable to attend the meeting. CM Duncan stated that he is searching for board members to sit on the Wyohelp board of directors and is asking if there is a council or staff member interested in serving on the board. Anyone interested is to contact CM Duncan.

POLICE ITEMS: PC Moen reported: She has been monitoring traffic and all is good in town.

LEGAL ITEMS: TA Barnes reported: She worked with the Town and the Lingle Volunteer Fire Department on the ISO rating for the fire department.

MAINTENANCE ITEMS: Town Supervisor Dailey reported: The swimming pool officially closed for the season the week prior to Labor Day. The Tree Board relocated and replanted a tree from the Bill Harris residence at Whipple Park. Roy's Tree Service has begun removing trees at the cemetery. The dog waste stations have been installed at the park. Midco has completed the repairs to the water tank, while repairs to the west water well at the cemetery are currently underway. TS Dailey and ATS Jackson will be attending safety training in Lusk. The WMPA Annual Meeting will be held next week in Cody, Wyoming, with Mayor Siglin attending the annual meeting and TS Dailey attending the board meeting.

LVFD ITEMS: PC Bangerter reported: The fire department responded to five ambulance calls and one fire call during the past month. The haunted house will tentatively take place in October.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C/T Reyes reported: He attended a Zoom meeting regarding the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. Due to the Town of Lingle's 45% Low-to-Moderate Income (LMI) rating, the Town does not qualify for CDBG funding for the Sewer Rehab Project. An Infrastructure Grant application has been submitted to Go Goshen for tree removal at the Lingle

Cemetery, utilizing the bid submitted by Roy's Tree Service in the amount of \$16,800. C/T Reyes informed the Town Council that he will be attending the Fall WAMCAT meeting in Casper, Wyoming, September 16–18, 2026. All required documentation for the Town's Annual Census – F-66 has been submitted to MHP, LLC. C/T Reyes also informed the Council of his intention to retire in October 2027.

NEW BUSINESS: Following discussion CM Duncan moved to approve support of the Goshen County Veteran's Banner Program in the amount of \$250.00. CM Wilhelm voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

COUNCIL ITEMS: CM Duncan informed the Council that a meeting for WCDA grants will take place August 15th and the Region 1 WAM meeting will take place October 7, 2026 in Torrington. CM Wilhelm mentioned that the council is available to all Town of Lingle residents. Following discussion, it was agreed to have a town Strategic Planning meeting October 21, 2026. Mayor Siglin proposed waiving the September 23, 2026, regular Town Council meeting. It was noted that, should Town business require Council action, the public would be notified and a special meeting would be scheduled as necessary. CM Duncan moved to waive the September 23, 2026, regular Town Council meeting. CM Wilhelm voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

With no further business to come before the Council, Mayor Siglin adjourned the meeting at 6:38 PM.
