## Dumpster Do's & Don'ts

The following items **CANNOT** be placed in the **Brown TDS Trash Containers**: Ashes, Tires, Sod, Wire or Cable, Metal, Yard Waste, Batteries, Rock, Wire Fencing, Iron, Appliances of any type, Concrete/Cement, Air Conditioners or anything with refrigerant, Dead animals or parts of animals, E-waste - Computers, computer monitors, keyboards, etc.



**ONLY** the following can be placed in the **Green TDS Trash Containers**: Grass Clippings, Flowers, Garden/Yard Waste, Weeds.

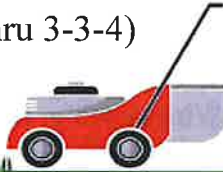
## Lawn Mowing/Weeds
